

## **Anawan Farm CSA WorkShare Program:**

Due to COVID-19, we have decided to limit our usually 20 slots to 10 open slots. We have chosen work that can be accomplished by being socially distanced with minimal guidance. You will need a mask to interact with the public or when not possible to be properly distanced from one another. You will not need to wear it

working as long as you are 10feet away from another person in a field. Work remains 4 hours per week on the farm to earn a variety of vegetables to take home each week. A **4-week minimum commitment is required to start earning**vegetables. Your 4 weeks can be retroactive. Meaning you must work the 4 weeks, but you will earn 4 weeks while working. We try to match your skills as appropriately as possible to the jobs we have on the farm. Sometimes, we really need to keep our weed suppression down by weeding. Do NOT be discouraged. Weeding is one of, if not, THE most important job on the farm. Plants are healthier and grow faster without weeds!

All applicants are considered on a first come, first serve basis. If you are not chosen, please feel free to purchase produce at our farm stand. We try to be as supportive to our community as possible. We may have a few workshare returnees from last year. We encourage applicants to apply ASAP and if you have friends interested, share this info packet with them!!!!



### **Volunteers With Benefits!**

Normally, we offer attendance to many workshops but we cannot participate in them this year. We are generous on our farm and want to encourage community involvement. All program attendees have the added benefit of attending NOFA 2021 Virtual Summer Conference this year. It is being held virtually. I'm so excited as I can only usually attend the winter conference. There is an abundance of information for everyone from the average gardener to the seasoned farmer at the NOFA conferences.

## What Kind of Veggies Are Available?

Each week will vary in the assortment of vegetables you get (some vegetables will overlap from week to week depending on what is in season). A variety of herbs, Eggplant, Summer Squash, Zucchini, Bush Beans, Snap Peas, Radishes, Cucumbers, a variety of peppers, Sweet Corn, Kale, Kohlrabi, Carrots, Beets, Butternut (also known as winter squash), Pumpkins, Spaghetti Squash, Small bunch of Fresh Cut Flowers. Generally, we grow over 30 different varieties of veggies across three seasons. **AF Workshare Vegetable Pick-Up:** You may take what



vegetables you would like to use upon your leaving of your shift. You are responsible for picking any vegetables or flowers that are not on display at the farmstand.

## **AF Workshare Requirements:**

We usually supply appropriate protection from the sun. However, COVID has changed everything. There will be a box with your name on it, you may place your items in it, and it will be yours for the season.

#### The following items are required to work on our farm:

1. A sunhat and Mask 4. XL Water Bottle or TWO

2. Garden Gloves 5. Snacks/Lunch/Break Food

3. Sunscreen 6. Proper Shoes and Bug Spray

### **Our Expectations Along with What to Expect:**

- Workers may be asked to perform hard physical work for 4 hour periods of time: lifting up to 50lbs, bending, sitting, squatting, standing, carrying, pulling, weeding, hoeing, thinning crops, planting, harvesting, digging, washing produce, packaging produce, fulfilling online orders, cleaning up around the farm, etc.
- You must be able to withstand HEAT to participate in our work share program.
- You must be comfortable working with animals, specifically dogs. We have a large breed hypoallergenic herding dog on the farm. He is a pup at heart (3yrs old/100lbs). Being comfortable & patient with a farm dog!
- There will be days when the weather is less than desirable (rain or muddy shine), but we will still work. We ask that you always review the weather report for your work share day, but also prepare for the possibility of varied weather conditions; dress appropriately for the weather and come out to the farm.
- The most important thing to keep in mind is that we are a working farm. We must work fast and efficiently. It's important that you always focus on the task at hand and refrain from using telephone/electronic gadgets. We reserve the right to cancel any workshare at any time due to overuse of ALL personal electronic gadgets.
- You must provide your own reliable transportation.
- WORKING INDEPENDENTLY. I am not only farming but managing everything associated with our farm. I cannot be there with our workshares 80% of the time.
- **Due to COVID-19:** There are NO children allowed this year on the farm with our workshares. We apologize but we cannot take any risks of sickness on anyone's behalf. We cannot accept anyone else working on our farm but the person who signs the agreement.
